'Party in the Park' Warley Woods. B67 5ED. Fundraising, but also fun for all visitors.

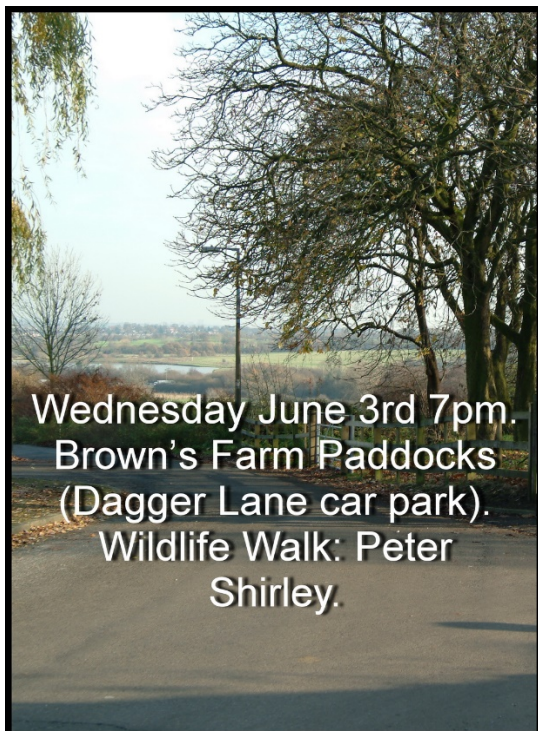
Great Barr Park -from St Margaret's. B43 7BA.
